EASY FUNDRAISING

Easyfundraising has boosted our funds by another £75 in the last 3 months.

THANK YOU to those of you that made online purchases through Easyfundraising.

Some of you who are already registered as a supporter may have been shopping online but not done it via Easyfundraising. PLEASE can I encourage you to do so.

If you have not signed up yet, then this <u>link</u> will take you to the Easyfundraising website. You will first be asked to register and to nominate the Club you would like to support (very easily done), and hopefully you will select Prestbury Bowling Club as your choice. Once you have registered, the procedure is very simple. It's even easier if you bookmark the Easyfundraising website so that one click will take you there straightaway.

If you already know where you are going to make your purchase, then go to the Easyfundraising page, start typing in the brand name you want (Amazon, Marks and Spencer, John Lewis and hundreds more), select it when it appears on the list, and then click on "Shop Now". That will take you directly to the shop that you have searched for (Amazon, John Lewis etc), and you then continue on making your purchase as usual.

When you are in Easyfundraising, you'll notice that next to each of the brand names you will see what percentage of your purchase price will be automatically donated to Prestbury Bowling Club. Even though making a small purchase - with perhaps only 1% donation, seems too small to bother, remember that with our 70 or more Club supporters, those pence do add up and are so helpful to our Club.

If you're just browsing the Internet and you see something you want to buy, perhaps from say, John Lewis, you can put your purchases into your basket and – if you haven't already done so – go back to Easyfundraising, choose John Lewis, and then click onto "Shop Now", which will take you back to John Lewis. From there, you pay as usual, but the difference is that a percentage of your payment will be donated to our Club.

Remember it does not cost you a penny more when using Easyfundraising.

I realise some of you may be supporting other causes via Easyfundraising or other such websites and I am not suggesting you change, but if you are not doing either PLEASE sign up and support the Club's efforts to boost our funds.

This is the time of the year when online shopping is at a peak so please follow it up as soon as possible and really boost our funds. We will earn a £5 bonus donation if you successfully join and raise £5 as a supporter through this link.

Just click on this <u>link</u> to see how it works and join us - it only takes minutes to do so. Sometimes you will find that the link will open to an advertisement for a particular shop, insurance company etc. If this happens, click where it says "Continue to website", and you will be taken to Easyfundraising.
